"5 And he said to them, "Which of you who has a friend will go to him at midnight and say to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves, 6 for a friend of mine has arrived on a journey, and I have nothing to set before him'; 7 and he will answer from within, 'Do not bother me; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed. I cannot get up and give you anything'? 8 I tell you, though he will not get up and give him anything because he is his friend, yet because of his impudence he will rise and give him whatever he needs. 9 And I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. 11 What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent; 12 or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? 13 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

Digging Deeper

1) Recap some of the ideas from our study in verses 1-4.

- 2) Look at verses 5-8.
 - a) Exploring the details of the story, discuss the different reasons why this "friend" was so rude?
 - b) What are some examples of when you've given into people because they pestered you?

c) If Jesus point isn't "you need to pester God shamelessly to overcome his reluctance," what's the point?

3) This passage suggests that God will not grant some requests you don't keep praying about.

- a) Where do you see this in our passage?
- b) Do the words "asking," "seeking" and "knocking" suggest different things?

c) How do you know when to stop praying for something (compare this passage with 2 Corinthians 12:7-10)?

d) Why do you think God wants us to seek so hard for some things before he grants them?

4) Look at verses 11-13. God doesn't always give you what you are praying for because you can't see that it will hurt you. He sees a scorpion when you see a fish. His "no" or "not yet" is the bread you really need! Share with the group a prayer that you are thankful God didn't grant because it wasn't good or the right time? Can you think of any Biblical examples?

5) In verse 13 Jesus says that God gives the Holy Spirit to us when we pray for various things.

a) We receive the Holy Spirit and are sealed with him when we become Christians (cf. Eph. 1:13; 4:30). What is another way we continue to "receive" God's Holy Spirit after we have Him (Eph. 5:18)?

b) On Sunday pastor Jake said this verse might refer to God's empowerment to get an answer to prayer. Can you think of examples from Scripture and everyday life when God empowers people to get their answer?

Take some time praying for any or all of these areas:

- That you and the members of your group would grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus.
- The salvation of friends and family.
- God's gospel work to flourish in our community through our church.
- The peace and prosperity of our country; especially for the upcoming elections.
- The persecuted church seeking to make Jesus known in the nations.
- Your individual needs.
