- 1. Read Exodus 20:14 and Matthew 5:27-30. What does the seventh commandment teach us about how God views sex?
- 2. Why is adultery treated as such a serious sin? What far-reaching effects does it have?
- 3. What immediate and potential consequences of premarital sex make it such a dangerous sin?
- 4. In what ways does the relationship between a husband and wife mirror the relationship between God and his people?
- 5. How does adultery dishonor the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?
- 6. What lesser or inward forms of adultery are people tempted to excuse as being "not that serious"?
- 7. Read 2 Samuel 11:1-17; 12:1-15. What poor decisions led up to David's temptation?
- 8. What principles can we learn from David's fall about how to keep the seventh commandment?
- 9. Read Psalm 51. What are the main components of David's confession? (It might be helpful to write a brief outline of this psalm.)
- 10. How can you apply this study of the seventh commandment to your own life?
 - a. Are you doing anything that would lead to inward or outward adultery?
 - b. How can you avoid these temptations?
