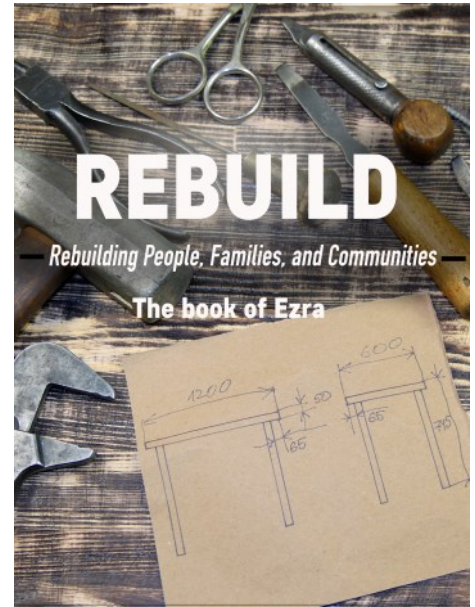

Building Campaign Update**



In 2016 God stirred our hearts to pray and plan about how our church might better love the people of Mason County with the gospel through our facility and ministries; serving both the members of our church and families in our community. Our mission is to be a thriving multigenerational church that draws many people and families into Jesus' family.

We recognize that our building has always been a critical tool in the mission of our church, and certainly in this mission. With the help of so many members of our church in 2016, we worked on a plan to enhance our facility to be more accessible, safe, welcoming, and effective in serving people. And in October of 2016, we commenced a capital campaign in which the members of our church pledged \$878,371.00! **Here we are in 2019** with siding that makes the exterior of our building look brand new, as well as a breathtaking children's area completed. And now we are in the last phase that includes an Elevator and Lobby Renovation. And we are in need of just over 199K dollars more of pledges, to cover the total building cost with our capital campaign. We believe this is a wonderful opportunity for God's people to come together and finish strong.

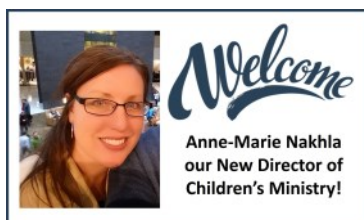
