This is a wonderful opportunity to reach outside the walls of our church and minister to others with the Gospel.

We have a board with **specific needs** for the event – take one, and purchase a few items for us! Or give cash donations toward CDs for kids and T-Shirts for staff.

We also need counselors – folks who are willing to take on a group of 10-15 kids, and go from station to station with them. You don't need to plan or teach anything...you get to know the kids, talk with them, and love them in Jesus' name. This is the most relational part of our outreach.
