Our summer discipleship trip is set, and this is the biggest trip yet! We'll partner with YWAM Idaho for our ten-day-long Big Summer Missions. The first four days will be spent at a camp near Warm Lake. This mountain location has no cell phone reception and will be the perfect place to focus on our relationships with the Lord, worship, grow together, and prepare for our outreach. The outreach portion will be spent in Boise.

Partnering with **YWAM** Idaho, we'll spend a week working with the large refugee population. Boise has a long legacy of welcoming people who are fleeing persecution, often with only the clothes on their backs! Our students have a chance to build relationships, share the Gospel through VBS and music. The trip will be unlike anything we've ever done, and I cannot wait to see all God will do.
