FBC Family,

As you know, we are in the midst of the giving portion of our Families Reaching Families stewardship campaign. Since the last reveal, we have been working to update the process for moving forward, since the total pledges are currently less than the cost of the goal project, which was estimated at \$1.5 million. The report below was provided as a handout to those attending the Annual Meeting on June 11. However, many were not in attendance, so the report is reproduced here to make sure the family is up to speed with the direction we are moving.



Current FRF Pledge Total:

\$860,619 pledged since Oct. 2016,
to be given over 3 years

Current FRF Giving Total:

\$176,715 pledge funds given to date

Pre-Campaign Giving:

\$ 56,781

Total Anticipated Giving:

\$917,400 including pre-campaign giving

Items Completed to Date:

Exterior Siding Project

Total cost:

\$151,000, paid in full

Funds borrowed from FBC savings:

\$ 95,981, now returned to savings from FRF funds

Anticipated Budget for Future Project(s):

\$750,000 after contingency

Project Development Process

Revisit original goals and determine revised project priorities – COMPLETE (see below)

Project Design Priorities

Accessibility

Install elevator, with related changes as necessary (accessible door, equipment area, etc.)

Young Children's Ministry areas

Relocate nursery so that infant through 3rd grade spaces are located together
Improve security and clarity of children and parent interface (check-in or drop-off area)
Remodel/refurbish finishes so that this ministry area communicates the value we place on young children and young families, emphasizes their needs and priorities, and is attractive to them

Lobby Enhancements

Improve circulation paths and congestion wherever feasible, given the limited resources
Improve the entry experience where possible (openness, welcome space, level changes, etc.)
Improve the directness of connections to worship and ministry spaces where possible
Improve signage and wayfinding
Provide added technology opportunities

Potential Added Priorities (only if/as resources allow)

Worship Center

Improvements to aging lighting, audio, and visual systems
Daylighting controls

Restrooms, halls, and other public areas

Replace/upgrade aging finishes and accessories
