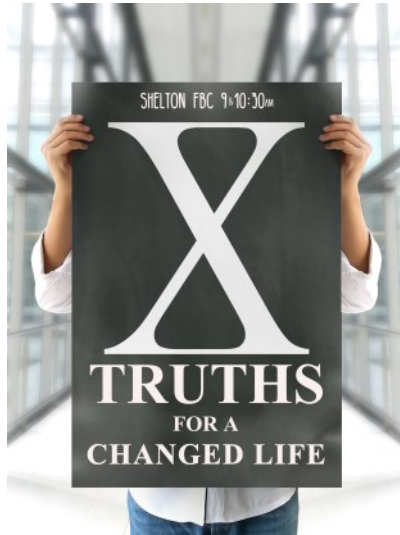

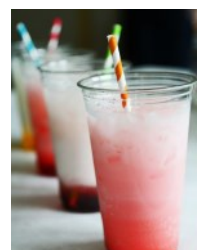
- The 5th street side door, will now only lead upstairs, or to the office.
